Beverly Maybank Burgdorf

Growing up in North Georgia and South Carolina, Beverly graduated from Converse College in 1991 with a BA in studio art and a minor in Art History.

In college, she studied and learned many different styles and forms of art but was most impressed by the works of the Cubists, Southern Folk Artists, Modern Masters and Pop Artists – the styles of whom play a large role in her own style.

Running galleries and doing her own artwork, Beverly later taught art in a parochial school in Columbia, S.C.

Her work was in locations in South Carolina, Georgia and North Carolina.

In 2004, she moved with her family to Williamsburg, Va., where she was the artistic designer of a pioneering line of children's clothes.

In 2014, Beverly and her husband opened Colonial Folk Art Studio & Gallery in Williamsburg where she is the artist-in-residence.

As the artist-in-residence, Beverly selects artwork and artists for the gallery, teaches classes, and assists other artists working on their own projects in the open studio.

The Frames

Frames can make or break a piece of art and this isn't lost upon Beverly. In fact, each piece of her framed works is an artwork itself.

The gallery commissions each frame from a wood artist Michael Lackey

from Hampton, Va. Michael individually makes each frame from locally reclaimed wood from barns, houses and fences.

All of the wood is naturally distressed and maintains a rustic character.

Historically Unique

Many of Beverly's works feature pieces of actual history.

Her husband, buys, sells and conserves antiquated books. When there are elements of books, or even whole books, that cannot be saved, he gives them to Beverly to use in her paintings.

For example, some of her works have included parts and engravings from the 1852 1st Editions of the book, "*Uncle Tom's Cabin.*"

These unique bits add to story of the works and adds to the uniqueness of each piece. It also adds to the conversational nature of the pieces.


